Announcement

1. Background

In October 1813, over 600,000 soldiers from all over Europe fought in and around Leipzig during the greatest battle of history until that time. Over 100,000 soldiers and civilians died in this decisive battle in the war against Napoleon, which was later called Battle of Nations. To commemorate the dead, the Monument to the Battle of Nations, the highest monument in Germany, was unveiled in 1913.

In 2018, Leipzig will be the place for a peaceful encounter all about music. Choirs from all over Europe will sing with and for each other. A central concert location will be the Monument to the Battle of Nations with its unique acoustics.

2. Participation

The event is open to choirs of all genres and styles. It is not a competition. Participation in all activities is optional and must be confirmed upon application.

3. Programme

The following events are offered:

Friday, 22 June 2018:	Reception at the City Hall of the City of Leipzig Joint concert with a choir from the Leipzig region
Saturday, 23 June 2018:	Performance in the Leipzig city centre Long Night of Choirs at the Monument to the Battle of Nations
Sunday, 24 June 2018:	Singing during a service at a church in the Leipzig region

Rehearsal facilities will be provided.

4. Organiser:

The Leipzig Choral Association is the umbrella organisation for over 90 choirs from Leipzig and the surrounding area. It is a non-profit organisation and is run mainly by volunteers.
